Berg department


- Inmates with long sentences, mainly from the eastern region in Norway
- National responsibility for progressionoriented offer to inmates in all of Norway.
- Capasity for 48 male inmates
 - Including 4 preventive detention
- Average length of sentence: 6,5 years
- Average residence time: in excess 1 year
- Serious offences





46 inmates (per 23.02.25)

- 11 violence/ homicide
- 25 sexuality offences
- 7 drug offences
- 3 financial crime/ robbery/ other





Local departments in Berg










- Technical
 - Depot, maintenance, carpentry

- Day-release
 - Work/apprentice training, upper secondary or higher education

Interdisciplinary collaboration

- Responsibility group is the core of the interdisciplinary collaboration with the individual inmate
- The participants are mainly the inmate, contact officer, sosial advisor, work officer, school and health department. If needed; activity officer, NAV (Norweagian work and welfare service), probation offices, child care service or others.
- The first responsibility meeting must be held 1 month after arrival and every third month after that
- Work mapping, collaboration meetings and professional group meeting




Dynamic security
